Through a national competition 15 companies were selected among which VAI. VAI pitched its products produced under the macro-nutrient fortification project that is largely funded by the Netherlands Organization for Scientific Research (NWO).

Yunus Social Business (YSB), builds upon the success of social business in Bangladesh, where social businesses have worked scale. The Yunus Uganda Social Business Accelerator is the Second in Africa, and the first in Sub Saharan Africa within the YSB network. Social Business Entrepreneurs with the most promising and compelling social businesses were selected for the program that lasted 10 weeks and is completely free. During this time, we were taken through a rigorous program with 5 dimensions, designed to help scale up social business and become exemplary game-changers in the society. Some specific benefits:

- Training in critical social business scale-up skills
- Joining a network of 100 worldwide social businesses
- Opportunities for business financing
