


Strategic Goals of F&BKP

- Facilitate knowledge and research that suit Dutch and local entrepreneurs, traders and investors.

Knowledge Agenda

- F&NS and poverty reduction are central (development perspective).
- Link with networks which are developing new solutions / business models and have much experience to offer.
- Topics where the Netherlands has added value and can make a difference.
- Clear demand from practice and policy (existing and emerging networks/CoPs, private sector, ministry, embassies).
- Knowledge @ work; opportunities for application.
- Impact at system level (enabling environment: business, policy, ...).
- Prospect to generate new knowledge and innovations (technological, methodology, organisational, institutional).



What can you do in the F&BKP?

- Disseminate relevant research results, good practices and innovative approaches.
- Create synthesis documents, overview articles, policy papers and other (visual) materials.
- Organize (international) online or offline dare-to-share dialogues and debates.
- Develop jointly-focused knowledge and innovation strategies.
- Establish (international) learning partnerships.
- Feed policy in the field of food and nutrition security.
- Organize (international) conferences.
- Translate research results and learning experiences into practice.
- Receive assistance in exploring (national and international) research funds.

F&B Global Challenges Programme

- Objective: To promote research based advanced understanding of emerging key issues in global and regional food security and their impact on local food security and the role of private sector development.
- Main applicant: Dutch research institute.
- Geographical focus: global.
- Total budget: €15M / Project budget: €500,000 €1M.
- Duration of projects: fast track 2 years; regular 4 5 years.



F&B Applied Research

- Objective: To promote research supported innovations that contribute to food security and private sector development in DGIS partner countries. Demand driven questions.
- Main applicant: practitioner organization in partner country.
- Geographical focus: 15 partner countries of Dutch Development Cooperation.
- Total budget: €15M / Project budget: €50,000 €300,000.
- Duration of projects: 0.5 3 years.
