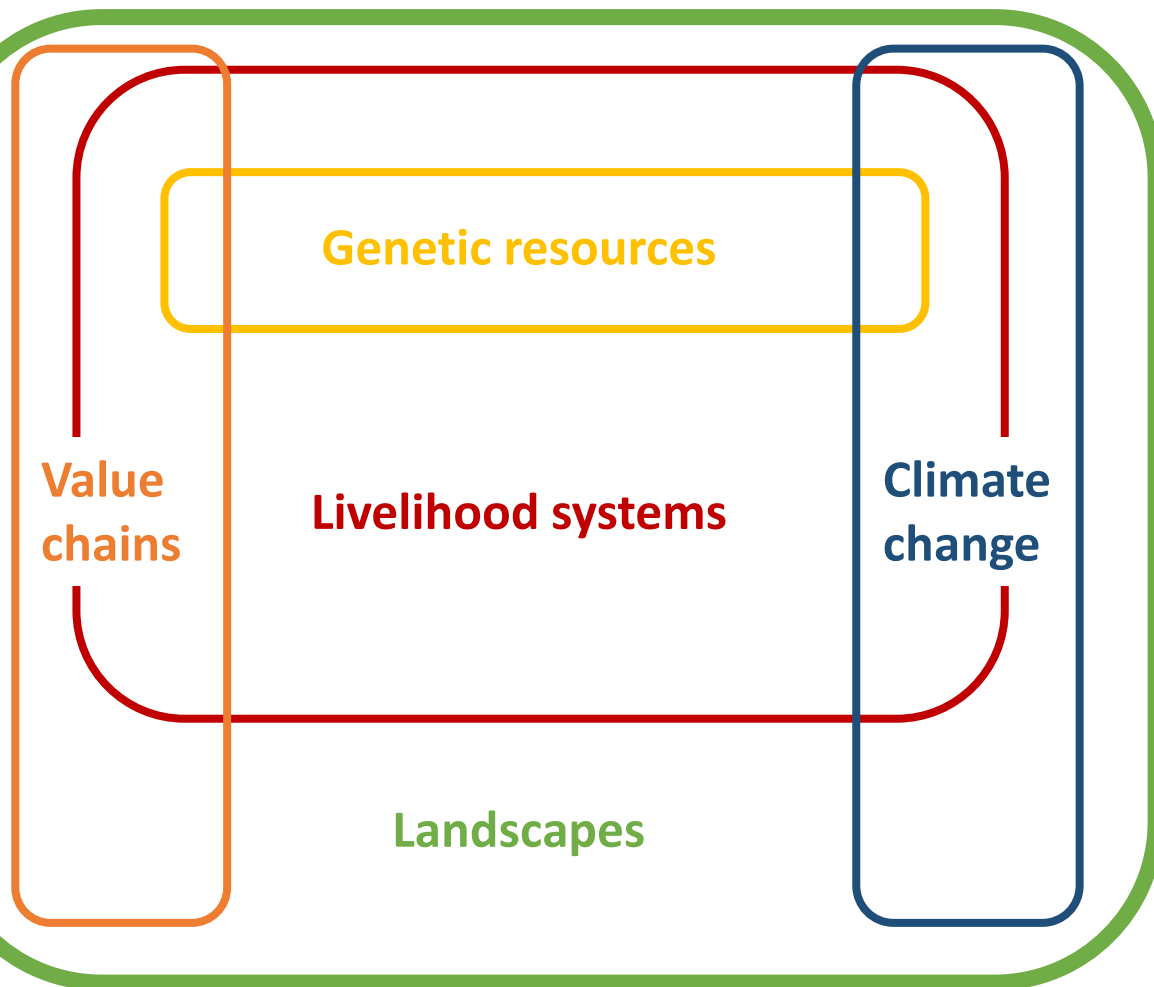

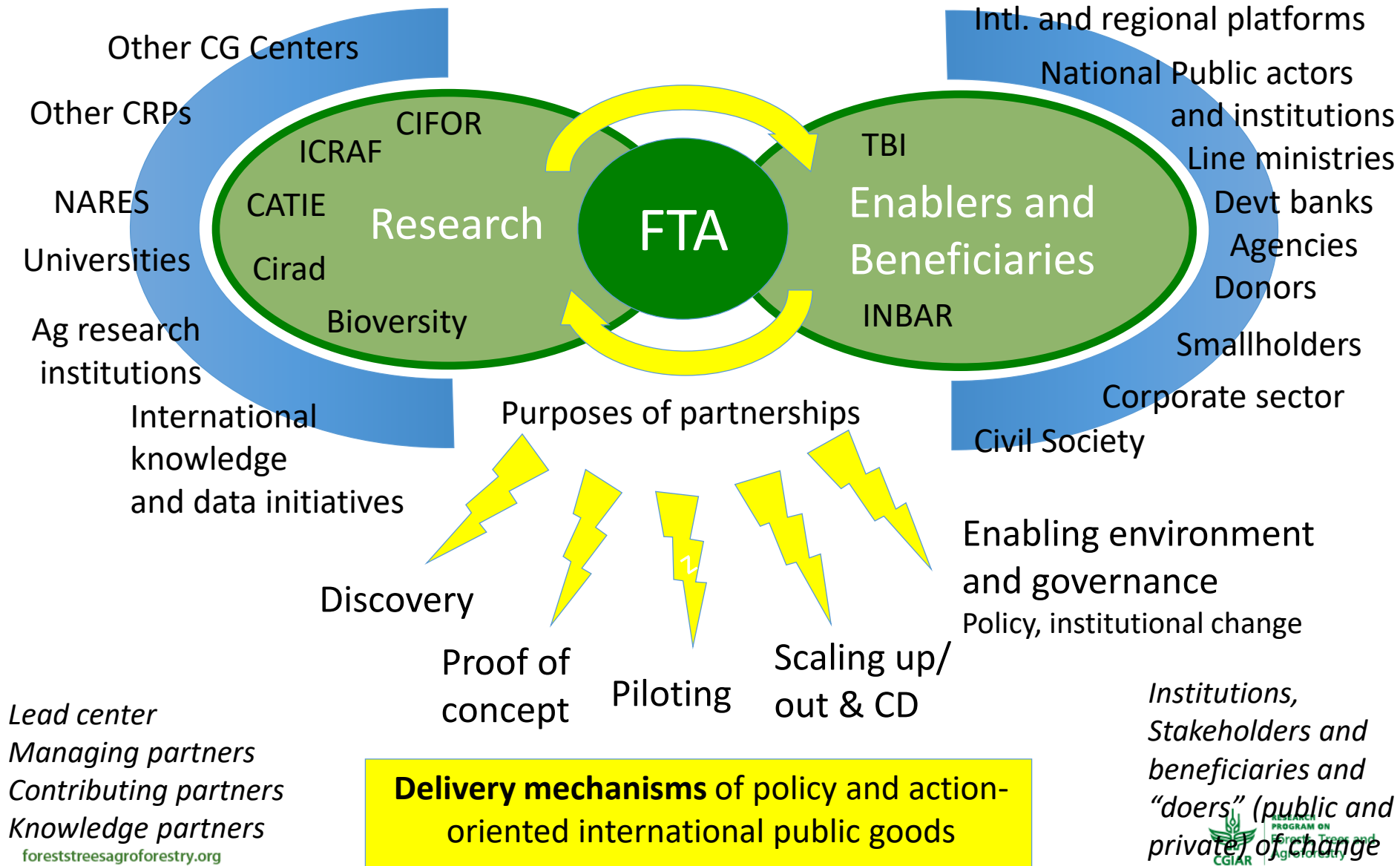

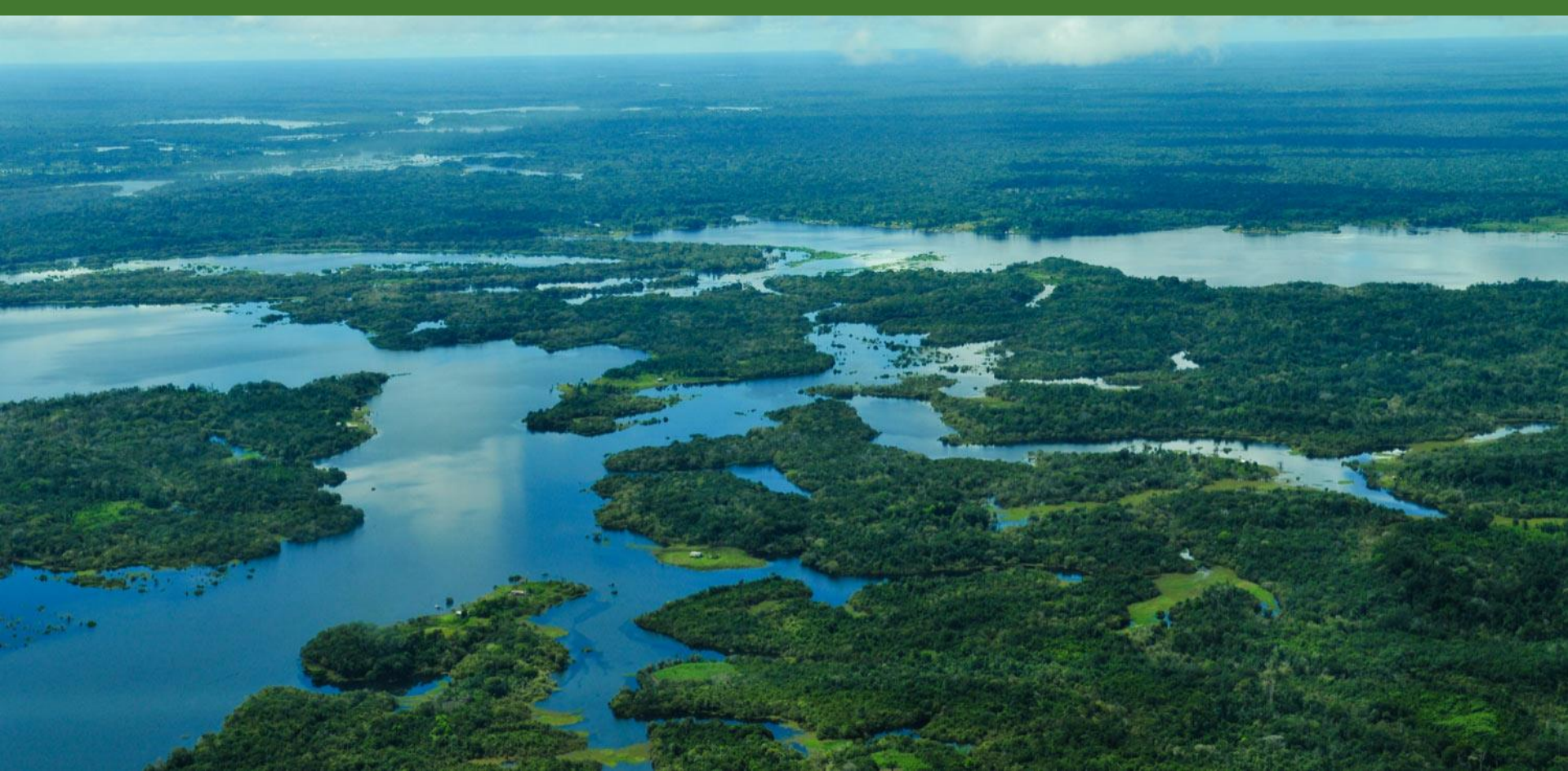

# Highlights of 2017

- Adoption of Vietnam's revised forestry law in 2017, with important technical support from FTA in 2016-2017
- Collaborative agreement with the Netherlands Development Organisation (SNV), with focus on palm oil in Indonesia and cacao in Ghana
- In Ghana was established a multi-sector stakeholder alliance for sustainable cocoa
- learning platforms were established for sustainable business in Uganda, Tanzania and Mozambique with support from the (Dutch-based) Shared Value Foundation.
