


The CGIAR Research program on Forests, Trees and Agroforestry (FTA)





Highlights of 2017

- Adoption of Vietnam's <u>revised forestry law</u> in 2017, with important technical support from FTA in 2016-2017
- <u>Collaborative agreement</u> with the Netherlands Development Organisation (SNV), with focus on palm oil in Indonesia and cacao in Ghana
- In Ghana was established a <u>multi-sector stakeholder</u> <u>alliance</u> for sustainable cocoa
- <u>learning platforms</u> were established for sustainable business in Uganda, Tanzania and Mozambique with support from the (Dutch-based) Shared Value Foundation.
