Platform mandate

- Housed in CGIAR Research Program on Policies, Institutions and Markets (PIM)
- Coordinated by KIT Royal Tropical Institute (Amsterdam)
- Serves all 12 CGIAR Research Programs and 15 Centers
- Builds on phase 1 Gender Network but with a stronger focus on gender research

Main objectives

- Increase visibility, profile and appreciation of gender research within CGIAR and internationally
- Build up the **quality** of CGIAR gender research, e.g. by supporting knowledge-sharing to promote joint approaches and methods, capacity development and fostering adherence to minimum standards for sex-disaggregated data collection and analysis
- Assess and support cross-CGIAR gender research priorities and identify gaps
- Foster and catalyze **strategic partnerships**

Who

- CRP Gender Research Coordinators (GRCs) and gender representatives from each Center
- Scientists doing gender research across CGIAR (including biophysical and social scientists)
- Website, webinars and e-newsletters to reach a broad international audience interested in gender and agriculture/NRM




Vis-a-vis NL-CGIAR Partnership priorities

- Platform works with all CRPs and Centers, including on gender dimensions of the Dutch priority themes:
 - climate smart agriculture
 - agriculture for nutrition and health
 - value chains
 - genetic improvement (breeding)

Main challenge

- Resource mobilization
- Internal barriers to resource mobilization for the Platform due to the financing structure of CGIAR

<u>BUT</u>

 Addressed by the Systems Council endorsement of the CGIAR Collaborative Platform for Gender Research becoming a fully fledged Capital "P" CGIAR Platform



Synergies with other CRPs/Platforms

- System-wide mandate on gender research work with <u>all</u> CRPs and CGIAR Centers
- Regular communication with Gender Research Coordinators from all CRPs and Centers (call-ins)
- Collaboration with the CGIAR Big Data Platform to embed gender into their work
- Conferences, webinars and newsletters open also to non-CGIAR partners
- Gender Research Integrated Training (GRIT) for postdoctoral fellow (legacy phase 1) – ongoing collaboration with Pennsylvania State University

2018 highlights

- Workshop with 2017 grantees for the gender dynamics in seed systems projects – towards a Special Issue on the topic
- Annual scientific conference at International Livestock Research Institute (ILRI) Campus Addis Ababa September 25-28
- Collaboration with the Big Data Platform, including the October convening
- Regular webinars, blogs, campaigns and newsletters (e.g. June!)
- Synthesis of CGIAR work on Gender Transformative Approaches (GTAs) and related expert meeting (in discussion)
