**Pasture is needed for livestock**, to produce milk and meat. But how to do this when you live in the drylands?

This webinar will discuss first results of an applied research in Kitui County, Kenya. On growing indigenous grasses coupled with road water harvesting. Experiments and comparison was done at a local university and with farmers themselves.

We discuss the characteristics of grass biomass, nutritional values and relation with soil moisture. What types of grasses and practices are recommended, and what is the future for pasture in drylands?
